- C** – *Contact the EMS* – communicate the right information to ensure the best possible response from arriving medical professionals.
- T** – *Treat the Injured with Life Sustaining Care* – “ABCSS of trauma” – Learn jaw thrust rescue breathing, when and how to remove a helmet, how to address external and internal bleeding and how to prioritize treatment.

The most likely person to be at the scene of a motorcycle crash is another motorcyclist. The primary goal of the class is to reduce severity of injury & fatalities at the scene of a crash through proper actions and reactions. We also educate the motorcyclist on how to protect themselves legally and financially.
